CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ⇒ Entry Fee is \$10.00 per work. (A discount is available for members of Orange Art Society Inc of \$8 per work) School Students \$5.00 per work. No painting/work can be larger than 1 metre by 1.3 metre. 2 small of 40cm x 40cm framed will count as one art work.
- ⇒ The Entry Fee and Form must be received by **5.00pm Friday, 2nd October 2015** and sent to the following address Art Competition **ANFD, 563 Borenore Road, BORENORE NSW 2800**
- ⇒ All works must be delivered to the ANFD site office (563 Borenore Road, Borenore NSW 2800) by 12.00 noon Friday 16th October 2015, ready for hanging/display. Art work must not have been previously entered in the ANFD art competition. Contact Phone number 02 6362 1588.
- ⇒ All works must be dry before delivery. Each painting must be suitably framed and fitted with a wire for hanging and other mediums appropriately mounted/based for display.
- ⇒ Exhibition dates are Thursday 22 October to Saturday 24 October 2015. Opening time at 8.30am to 5pm each day
- ⇒ An official cocktail party and winners announcements will be held on **Friday 23rd October 2015**. Free of charge – invitation to follow.
- ⇒ There will be 1st prize of \$500, 2nd prize of \$250, 3rd prize of \$150 PLUS a *People's Choice* prize of \$150 each plus 2 Young Artist prizes. The judges' decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- ⇒ All paintings/works must be available for sale during the event and a commission of 20% will be charged. Paintings that are unsold are not permitted to be taken from the ANFD site until the cessation of the field days and will be available for collection any time after 9.00am on Sunday 25th October 2015. Works must be collected by owner or written permission if to be collected by someone else, works will not be freighted back to artists.
- ⇒ The subject of all works – *Rural Art Competition* – must portray an agricultural entity/activity. This can include any farming, grazing, horticulture, viticulture, dairying or pastoral.
- ⇒ Please note – Every possible care will be taken but no responsibility is taken by both the ANFD Art Exhibition Committee and Orange Art Society Inc. for any work entered in the competition.
- ⇒ Display of all works will be carried out by the ANFD Exhibition Committee. The committee reserves the right to choose not to display any work that is considered offensive, too fragile, framed incorrectly, too heavy or the standard is not suitable to display.
